

Newsletter – December 2019

Dear project partners, below you find news, reminders and a short summary of the status of our project.

- Third report: We are awaiting approval of the partial payment claims and then we will finalize the joint report and hand it in to the Joint Secretariat.
- The successful operation of the pilot plant in Slagelse continues. The plant and some results was published by the Danish water and wastewater association in DANSKVAND in October (<http://www.e-pages.dk/danva/229/>)
- The pilot in Kretinga is expected to be in place in mid January. Then follows some mounting before start-up.
- The pilot in Svedala is up and running. We are working with adjustments of the membranes (high pressure and fouling) to optimize the operation.
- In Kristianstad Ola is analysing a lot of samples from the two pilots in DK and SE. Ola is also investigating the possibilities to include analysis of additional substances.
- Åsa & Michael attended the Interreg annual event in Ostroda, 24-25 September.
- Beata presented our project for the Baltic Sea Protection in Łódź 13 November
- Michael introduced our project at the Baltic Sea Region PIE Platform Workshop at the Swedish EPA in Stockholm, September 19th.
- The Less is more project was presented at the NordIWA conference (by Simon) 23-25 September in Helsinki.
- Michael gave an overview of Less is More at the final conference of the Morpheus project, in Lund December 10th.
