

Newsletter – March 2019

Dear project partners, below you find a short summary of the status of our project.

- The first joint report with financial payment claims is approved. All partners can expect reimbursement very soon.
- There is progress on all pilot plants. The Danish pilot is up and running, the Swedish pilot is about to be started and the tendering process started in Lithuania.
- In Kristianstad analysis methodology is being developed to include Benzotriazole on the list of substances.
- Laboratory studies are being performed in Sweden and Denmark in parallel to the pilot studies.
- Some of you have got a separate e-mail with questions related to technical specifications on each pilot plant to make sure we can produce a peer-review report according to plan. Please respond to Michael and Åsa as soon as possible.
- GFW has sent out a poster which should be placed in visible place at pilot plant stations, as well as in offices.
- Our project will be presented to the Morpheus project during their project meeting in Gdańsk in May. Less is More will also be a part of the pilot training run by the Morpheus project.
- A pharmaceutical Expert Cluster was created on LinkedIn.
- Less is more was presented at the Partner meeting of the Interreg SB project called Sludge Technological Ecological Progress (Acronym STEP) in Höör 26th February.
